

Ron Zimmerman has offered to spearhead a club campout at the Antique Gas and Steam Engine Museum in Vista October 17-21, 2024. Some of us have attended in the past and it's quite an interesting experience. This is "Dry Camping" but they do have a water fill and a dump station adjacent to the camp ground.

They require a minimum of 10 rigs to do the camp setting. They will put our group together and sites will accomodate rigs and tow vehicles. We will have space for tables and campfires, the latter being in portable pits at least 6 inches off the ground Total cost is \$160.00 for the 4 nights.

There is a separate entrance and exit to the camping area so we are free to come and go, and to enjoy other activities in the Vista area. By arriving on Thursday afternoon, we would arrive before some of the exhibitors, many of whom will come with their campers and equipment and will spend Friday setting up their exhibits.

Though not confirmed, the last time we went they had a great breakfast we could buy in one of the buildings on the property.
